Registration and Call for Abstracts

The 2023 ICG Biodiversity Symposium will take place on November 14 in the Goldberg Computer Science Building, 6050 University Avenue. All presentations will be held in the CS Auditorium (Room 127), and coffee breaks / lunch / poster sessions in the Atrium (0th Floor, by the Second Cup).

The symposium is intended to highlight the excellent research being conducted by all ICG members. This year's symposium will have a (non-exclusive!) theme of bioinformatics, phylogenetics, and machine learning. We will have speakers with expertise in ML and personnel from ACEnet who will provide an overview of the system and give tips on how to use it. Registration is free but we ask that you register at <https://forms.office.com/r/CPqEjwDuhR> so we can estimate numbers of participants.

Attendees are invited to submit abstracts for oral or poster presentations. Abstracts should be approximately 300 words in length and contain the following information:

- Title
- Oral presentation or poster
- List of authors with affiliations
- Introduction, Methods, Results, Discussion / Future Work (although these headings are not required)

Titles, authors, and affiliations do not count against the word limit. Oral submissions not selected will be offered a poster slot.

The deadline for abstract submissions is **Friday, October 20** at 11:59PM. Please submit your abstracts in PDF format with the filename formatted as "ICG-Abstract-Authorname.pdf" and upload them via Microsoft Form at <https://forms.office.com/r/98NMFS6GLp>.
